

**COMPETITION**  
**for scholarships for full-time students**  
**in academic 2015/16 year from funds provided by Bejtuzzakat from Kuwait**

I

On the basis of the Protocol on Cooperation with Bejtuzzakat from Kuwait there has been provided funding for **50 scholarships to students of the first cycles** of studies which Fund "Bošnjaci" will award according to the criteria, scoring system and territorial representation to full-time students at the **public** high level education institutions in Bosnia and Herzegovina, as follows:

II

Scholarships are awarded for period of academic 2015/16, from September 1, 2015 until August 31, 2016, which is 12 scholarships in monthly amount of **30.00 KWD**, which at this moment is equivalent to approx. **160.00 KM**. Payment will be made in KM according to valid exchange rate at the day of payment of Bejtuzzakat Fund from Kuwait.

III

**GENERAL CRITERIA:**

- a citizen of B&H;
- full time student at one of the **public** high level education institutions in Bosnia and Herzegovina;
- is not a student of art, musical, theatrical and other arts;
- is not repeating a school year;
- that the candidate does not receive scholarship from any other legal entity or an individual and does not receive financial compensation on any other basis;
- is not older than 27 years.
- is not entered into marriage;
- only one person from a household can get the scholarship

IV

**SPECIFIC CRITERIA:**

- results achieved in learning and behavior;
- a student or the first year of study (freshman) has to have the minimum grade point average of **4.50** in the final high school grade;
- a student of the first cycles of studies has to have the minimum grade point average of **7.50** in the previous academic year;
- reported specific results at cantonal, federal, national and international competitions in mathematics, physics, computer science and foreign languages for previous school/academic year in organization or by help of relevant ministry of education;
- financial resources of the family - social status;

V

For the first year students of a faculty (freshmen) the grade point average and other criteria are taken from the final year of the high school.

VI

Commission for scoring and establishing of nominations for scholarships will determine the number of points for each candidate according to the following:

- points based on the results achieved in learning, competitions etc.;
- points based on the average income per household member or on the social status of the candidate and her/his family;
- points based on previous use of scholarship, etc.

**REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:**

**a) General**

- application for scholarship (*download from the web site [www.fondbosnjaci.co.ba](http://www.fondbosnjaci.co.ba) or take in the Fund headquarters*);
- certificate about regular enrolment in academic year 2015/16;
- a certified copy of the first and second page of the index;
- certificate of citizenship;
- household list (*issued and certified by the municipality*);

- a written statement of the applicant that he/she is not and will not be a scholarship holder of the second legal entity or an individual nor will they exercise the right to financial compensation on other grounds in the academic 2015/16 year if they are awarded the scholarship by Fund "Bošnjaci" (*statement is given and verified by the municipality*).
- a written statement that of the candidate by which is given the approval to the Fund "Bosnians" for publication of personal data in publishing of ranking list and the results of the competition and other on the website of the Fund (*statement is given and verified by the municipality*).

**b) Documents which are rated**

- certificate of having passed the exams from the previous year with an grade point average calculated to two decimal places;
- for students of the first year of studying a certified copy of the diploma and certificate of the final high school grade and evidence that they were a pride or the pupil of the generation;
- evidence for winning of the first, second or third place at cantonal, federal, national or international competition in mathematics, physics, information science and foreign languages for the previous school/academic year organized by or via competent ministry of education;
- diploma of the Islamic Community in Bosnia and Herzegovina on passed Hifzi;
- proof of total monthly revenue/income of all adult household members based on: employment, pension, self-employment, protection of war veterans and other sources (*assurance of personal incomes for the last month for employed, last pension check for retired persons, IMO and LIMO checks, assurance of Employment service for unemployed household members, and if they are not registered in Employment service they will provide assurance from PIO/MIO office that are not registered as an insured person based on employment or certified copy of the health insurance booklet from which one can see information about the insured person, insurance basis or relationship with the insured person, for household members under six years Excerpt from the Register of birth*);
- a certificate which shows that no one of adult household members has own personal private business (*certificate of Tax Administration or other competent authority on the basis of which you can see whether or not they are kept in the register of taxpayers as entrepreneurs, or whether or not they are logged into a single system for the registration, control and collection of contributions as taxpayers on any grounds with reported monthly or annual income*);
- evidence for parents: a shahid family, without one or both parents (*Excerpt from the Register of deaths*), participation in DL war for at least 24 months, evidence for wartime disability of parents – over 60 or 80%;
- evidence about personal disabling of a candidate - over 60%;
- evidence for regular education of pupils/students in the family;

VII

In accordance with the provisions of Bejtuzzakat from Kuwait, the provisions of the endowment, the Decision on the number, structure and criteria for awarding scholarships in the academic year 2015/16. year for which funding is provided by Bejtuzzakat from Kuwait and other normative - legal acts of the Fund, the right to participate in the Competition have full time students of the **first cycle** of studies in **public** higher education institutions in Bosnia and Herzegovina with an average score of **7,50 or more** except students at the academies of art, musical, theatrical and other arts..

VIII

Together with an **application for scholarship (Form: ZBZ-2)** submit **original documents** or **certified** copies. An integral part of this Competition is the **System of rating of candidates (Form: SBBZ-2)** published on the web page [www.fondbosnjaci.co.ba](http://www.fondbosnjaci.co.ba) so the candidate is required to **perform own rating**.

IX

The deadline for submission of applications is **October 20, 2015**.

X

The results of the Competition will be announced at **the end of November 2015** on the web page of the Fund "Bošnjaci" Sarajevo – [www.fondbosnjaci.co.ba](http://www.fondbosnjaci.co.ba) with the right for complaint/appeal within **3 days** from the publication of the results.

XI

If it turns out that some of the recipients of the scholarship are double users or if it is found that they exercised the right to scholarship on the basis of false information, the Agreement on scholarships will be terminated with the same and they will be requested to return the paid funds.

XII

Untimely and incomplete applications **will not be taken into consideration**.
