Pursuant to Articles 20 and 30 of the Statute of Fund "Bošnjaci", the Rulebook on Awarding Scholarships to Pupils and Students in Bosnia and Herzegovina and the Decision of the Managing Board, Fund "Bošnjaci" announces

COMPETITION

for scholarships award to pupils and students in school/academic year 2021/22

I

Fund "Bošnjaci" awards **85 (eighty-five) scholarships** in the school/academic year 2021/22, as follows:

- 1 69 (sixty-nine) scholarships for students at public higher education institutions, of which:
 - a) 29 scholarships for full-time students of the first cycle of studies;
 - b) 15 scholarships for full-time second-cycle students and
 - c) **20 scholarships** for full-time students of the first and **5 scholarships** to the second cycle of studies in accordance with the Agreement on Cooperation with the Donor from the Republic of Turkey.
- 2 16 (sixteen) scholarships for high school students (proposed by schools):

Π

Scholarships are granted for academic/school year 2021/22 in monthly amounts of:

- a) 120,00 BAM for high school students in time period for 10 months,
- b) 150.00 BAM for students in the first cycle of studies in time period for 10 months,
- c) 170,00 BAM for students in the second cycle of studies in time period for 10 months,
- d) 170.00 BAM for students in the first and second cycle of studies with an average grade of 10.00 in time period for 10 months,
- e) 250,00 BAM for students in the first cycle of studies from donor funds from the Republic of Turkey in time period for 8 months and
- f) 350.00 BAM for students in the second cycle of studies from donor funds from the Republic of Turkey in time period for 8 months,

Ш

Three scholarships from Article I, paragraph 1 under a) will be awarded to students of the Faculty of Islamic Sciences in Sarajevo upon the proposal of the faculty.

IV

The right to scholarships from the Agreement on Cooperation with a donor from the Republic of Turkey will be exercised by 20 first-ranked students in the first and 5 in the second cycle of studies. In case of application of a large number of candidates with an average grade of 10.00, who have an unconditional right to a scholarship, donor scholarships will be awarded to students in accordance with the order of received documentation, which will be recorded upon admission.

v

General criteria for scholarships award to candidate that is:

- a) a citizen of B&H;
- b) resident at the territory of Bosnia and Herzegovina,
- c) full time student at The First Bosniak High School in Sarajevo or one of madrassas in Bosnia and Herzegovina,
- d) full time student at one of the public high level education institutions in Bosnia and Herzegovina,
- e) that the candidate is not and will not be a user of scholarship, loan or other form of financial compensation which has elements of a scholarship from any other legal entity or an individual,
- f) not older than 19 or 25 years on the day of competition announcement.
- g) meets general requirements from Vakufnama.

VI

Specific criteria for scholarships award:

- a) a pupil or a student of the first year of study (freshman) has to have **the minimum grade point average of 4.50** in the final high school grade;
- b) a student in the first cycles of the studies has to have **the minimum grade point average of 8.00** in the previous academic year;
- c) that the student in the second cycle of studies, in the final year of the first cycle, ie the first year of the second cycle of studies, achieved an **average grade of at least 9.00**;

- d) reported specific results at cantonal, federal, national and international competitions in mathematics, physics, information science and foreign languages for previous school/academic year in organization or by help of relevant Ministry of education;
- e) passed Hifz before the Commission of Riaset of IC in BiH;
- f) that none of the members of the immediate family is not user of Fund "Bošnjaci" scholarship;
- g) that the applicant does not have the status of a graduate student;
- h) that he/she is not employed and
- i) he/she is not repeating a year.

VII

An integral part of the competition is **scoring system of candidates** (**Form: SBFB-1**) on the basis of which the applicant is required to perform his/her own rating **on the application for scholarship** (**Form: ZFB-1**).

The rating system and application for scholarship award can be downloaded on the website **www.fondbosnjaci.co.ba** or at the Fund's headquarters.

VIII

The Commission for establishing of candidate nominations for scholarships determines the timeliness of the submitted application, completeness and validity of documentation, fulfillment of general and specific criteria laid down in the competition, checks the independent evaluation of candidates and other.

The Commission can request additional documentation and clarification from candidates or competent authorities during processing of submitted applications.

IX

The Commission will determine the number of points for each candidate according to the following:

- a) points based on the results achieved in learning, competitions and passed Hifz,
- b) points based on the average income per household, the social status of candidates and his/her family,
- c) points based on the number of pupils/students in the family and
- d) points based on previous use of the scholarship (the right to the points is earned by the candidates depending on the degree of fulfillment of the obligations under Article 5 of the Scholarship Agreement).

For the first-year students grade point average is taken from the final year of the high school, while for the first-grade students of a high school grade point average is taken from the final year of the primary school.

For students in the first year of the second cycle of studies, the grade point average is taken from the final year of the first cycle of studies.

X

In the event that two or more candidates have the same number of points, priority will be given to:

- a) candidates with higher average grade,
- b) candidates from the higher study year.
- c) previous scholarship holders of Fund "Bošnjaci".

XI

Candidates for scholarships submit original documents or certified copies which are not older than six months, as evidence to meet the criteria, together with the application.

1 General documentation

- a) Certificate of citizenship;
- b) Certificate on permanent residence, issued after publication of competition;
- c) Certificate about regular enrolment in current school/academic year;
- d) a written statement that the candidate is not and will not be a user of scholarship, loan or other form of financial compensation which has elements of a scholarship from any other legal entity or individual in the current school / academic year, if qualify for a scholarship of Fund "Bošnjaci";
- e) a written statement, in accordance with the Law on Amendments to the Law on Protection of Personal Data ("Official Gazette of BiH" No. 76/11), that the candidate approves to Fund "Bošnjaci" publication of personal data in publishing of ranking list and the results of the competition and other on the website and Facebook page of the Fund and other public media.

2 Documents which are rated:

- a) certificate of having passed the exams from the previous school/ academic year with a grade point average calculated to two decimal places;
- b) for students of the first year of studying a certified copy of the diploma and certificate of the final high school grade and evidence that they were given awards of the honors or the pupil of the generation;
- c) students of the first year of the second cycle of studies enclose a certified photocopy of the certificate of passed exams from the final year of the first cycle of studies with the calculated grade point average to two decimal places;
- d) evidence for winning of the first, second or third place at cantonal, federal, national or international competition in mathematics, physics, information science and foreign languages for the previous school/academic year organized by or via competent Ministry of Education;
- e) diploma of the Islamic Community in Bosnia and Herzegovina on passed Hifz;
- f) the household members list;
- g) proof of total monthly revenue/income of all adult household members (except those who have the status of regular pupils and students) on the basis of: employment, pension, self-employment, war veterans protection and other sources (exclusively pay

slip for the last month is required for employed household members, from which the actual income can be seen, for pensioners last pension check, IMO and LIMO checks, certificate of Employment service for unemployed household members, and if they are not registered in Employment service they will provide certificate from PIO/MIO office that they are not registered as insured person from employment or a certified copy of the health insurance booklet from which one can see information about the insured person, insurance basis or relationship with insured person, for household members under the age of six years a Birth certificate is required.)

- h) a certificate which shows that no one of adult household members (except for those who have the status of regular pupils and students) has own personal private business (certificate of Tax Administration or other competent authority on the basis of which you can see whether or not they are kept in the register of taxpayers as entrepreneurs, or whether or not they are logged into a single system for the registration, control and collection of contributions as taxpayers on any grounds with reported monthly or annual income);
- i) evidence for parents: the shahid's child, without one or both parents (Excerpt from the Register of deaths), participation in DL war (for at least 24 months), evidence for wartime disability of parents (over 60 or 80%),
- j) evidence about personal disabling of a candidate (over 60%) and
- k) evidence for regular education of pupils or students in the family.

XII

Full-time students of the first and second cycles of studies with an average grade of 10.00 are entitled for the scholarship if they meet the general criteria set out in Section V of the competition.

Candidates with an average grade of 10.00 shall enclose only the general documentation and certificate on passed exams from the previous academic year.

XIII

The deadline for submission of applications is **November 05, 2021.**

Untimely and incomplete applications will not be taken into consideration.

Documentation of candidates will not be returned.

XIV

The results of the Competition will be announced **at the second half of November 2021**, on the Web and Facebook page of Fund "Bošnjaci" Sarajevo and the Web portal of the Islamic Community in Bosnia and Herzegovina with the right for complaint/appeal to the Main Board of the Fund within **3 days** from the publication of preliminary results.

XV

The winners of the scholarship of Fund "Bošnjaci" will conclude a contract on scholarships for the current school / academic year that will regulate mutual rights and obligations.

XVI

Fund "Bošnjaci" will unilaterally terminate the contract on scholarship if it is established:

- a) that scholarship holder receives a scholarship, loan or other form of financial compensation which has elements of a scholarship from any other legal entity or individual,
- b) that the scholarship holder qualified for a scholarship on the basis of inaccurate or false information,
- c) that he/she abandoned regular schooling or has lost the right to it and
- d) that he/she does not respond to calls for participation in the planned activities of Fund "Bošnjaci" without justifiable reason.

In the event of unilateral termination of scholarships from Fund "Bošnjaci", scholarship holder is obliged to fully return received scholarships with permanent loss of the right to scholarships from Fund "Bošnjaci".
